COMPLETES INSULATION WORK AT
STONY BROOK UNIVERSITY***

NEW YORK—September 14, 2009—The Insulation Contractors Association of New York City, Inc. (ICA), is pleased to announce that member contractor, Thomas J. Donnelly Inc. (Donnelly), has continuously completed mechanical and plumbing insulation work at Stony Brook University, State University of New York (Stony Brook) located on Long Island's North Shore of Stony Brook, New York.

Donnelly has completed insulation work at Stony Brook for the past 10 years and is currently working on three separate projects for the University. Donnelly is presently completing HVAC and plumbing insulation in a 600-bed resident dorm of the University, which began in September of 2009. Donnelly is expected to complete the project in November of this year.

Donnelly has completed a wide variety of projects for Stony Brook University including the renovation of student housing, as well as insulation work in the H Quad, Kelly Quad, SUNY Humanities Building, the BioTech Building, and the SUNY Athletic Stadium which required firestopping of the curtain wall system. Donnelly has also completed a large amount of work in the University Power Plant which required insulation work on the underground high temperature hot water piping system, which was unique because of the fact that the University has their own central heating plant instead of individual boilers for each building.

Donnelly, enjoys the work they do for Stony Brook University because they have the opportunity to work on large scale projects in Long Island, where the firm is located and they work directly for the general contractor rather than the subcontractors, which is a rarity.
